AutoCAD is widely used in engineering, architecture, mechanical design, and construction. It has been the top-selling program for professional designers, since 2000, and the third-largest-selling program in the U.S. in 2013. History AutoCAD's predecessor, Primadyne, was first released by Autodesk in 1978, with functionality similar to the current AutoCAD. In 1981, Autodesk released AutoCAD RTM, a presentation-based tool that resembled a specialized CAD package from the 1980s. AutoCAD Display was a series of interactive CAD applications that accompanied the rollout of new RTM products, including 3-D, drafting, and engineering tools. AutoCAD Features AutoCAD supports only Windows operating systems (Microsoft Windows 7, Windows 8, Windows 10, Windows Server 2008, Windows Server 2008 R2, Windows Server 2012, and Windows Server 2012 R2) and macOS (Mac OS X 10.8 or later). AutoCAD runs on computers with an Intel Core i3, i5, or i7 processor (except for the Midrange and Workgroup configurations, which have slower processors), 8 GB of RAM, and at least a 12 GB hard drive, with the Office 365 subscription plan (\$50.00/month with a free one-year trial). The release of AutoCAD 2015 brought the release of AutoCAD LT (standalone version of AutoCAD), in which users can download a free copy of AutoCAD along with some complementary software. In September 2016, Autodesk began allowing commercial users of AutoCAD to purchase a subscription to add features and capabilities not available in the freeware program, such as 2-D and 3-D annotations, versioning, and table views. AutoCAD is also available for mobile devices (Android and iOS), with the latest versions available on the Google Play Store (beta) and the Apple App Store. AutoCAD for iPhone and iPad was first released in 2014, with AutoCAD for Android being released in January 2015. AutoCAD mobile apps are able to "share files, sketches, drawings, and dimensions with users and clients." These mobile apps are also integrated with AutoCAD 2016 and AutoCAD LT (version 2015 and 2016) for Windows. An increasing number of AutoCAD features are also available on the Web through free Web-based tools. Autodesk provides a free trial

the DWG files produced by the products listed above can be converted to DXF using the DWG2DXF app. While a number of these are offered with AutoCAD, none are officially supported by Autodesk. The company employs up to two professional software developers with a degree in computer engineering, and is in the process of training additional developers." Among the existing functionality Autodesk provides is a "Migrator" utility for converting files from previous AutoCAD versions to the current (as of 2011) release.
